What is Baptism?

Baptism is an outward display of what God has done for you inwardly or spiritually. Christ died for our sins...He was buried...and He rose again. (1 Corinthians 15:3-4) When you trust Christ, in an unseen or spiritual way, you are, Buried with him in baptism...who hath raised him from the dead. (Colossians 2:12) Baptism does not make you a believer, but it shows that you are a believer. The Bible clearly says that faith in Jesus Christ alone is what saves. Similar to the symbolism of a wedding ring, baptism is an outward symbol of faith in Jesus Christ as Savior. It illustrates your new life as a Christian. Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life. (Romans 6:4)

When should I be baptized?

As soon as you have decided to trust Christ, you can and should be baptized. Then Philip began with the scripture and preached unto him Jesus. And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water...what does hinder me to be baptized? And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. (Acts 8:35-38)

Why immersion?

Not only is this how Jesus was baptized, but it is also the only form of baptism found in the Bible. And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water. (Matthew 3:16) ...and they went down both into the water...and he baptized him. (Acts 8:38-39) The Greek word means, "To immerse or dip under water." It is the best symbol of spiritual burial and resurrection in Christ.

What is Family Dedication?

For this reason, we have a service of dedication to Christ for parents and their children with the goal that each child will one day choose to accept Christ as their personal savior.

What age can a child take part?

Any age. We deal with each family on an individual basis.
